- (b) One will be attached to L. of C. Area Records Office. The N.C.O. selected for this appointment may be provided from personnel classified medically fit, class B.
- (c) One section will be commanded by the sergeant and the other by a corporal.
- (d) One man in headquarters company and 1 man in each rifle company will be trained to repair boots as a part time employment. In each rifle company one man will be trained in hygiene duties and one man in first aid. Stretcher bearers may also be trained as bandsmen and one man as a bugler.
- (e) Will be trained in anti-gas duties and decontamination work.
- (f) Includes or is a corporal.
- (g) Includes 2 corporals.
- (h) Includes 3 corporals.
- (j) Includes 4 corporals.
- (k) Officers, regimental sergeant-major, provost sergeant, pay sergeant, regimental police, Nos. 1 and 2 of M.M.G. detachments, sergeants and corporals of 3-inch mortar detachments, twenty-four 2-inch mortar personnel and thirteen signallers are armed with pistols.
